

Writing:

As well as our Success for all (SfA) learning, we will also be improving our writing through our topic work in the afternoons. We will be considering our use of vocabulary in our sentences as well as editing and improving our writing. We will also be developing our knowledge of spelling patterns and dedicating time to improve hand-



Science:

At the beginning of the term we will be talking about the habitats of different animals and how this contributes to their characteristics. We will also discuss food chains, animals and plants.



Maths:

We have focussed on our place value during the first few weeks which will really help as we develop throughout the year. We have also been partitioning and rounding numbers to varying degrees of accuracy. In the next few weeks we will be reviewing our methods of calculation.



PSHE:

We will be talking about a number of different topics that we must consider in order to work effectively in the world. These include living in communities and empathy.
