English - We have made an excellent start in English and have been enjoying our mixed 'Success For All' sessions, across the school.

Maths - Beginning with place value, Year 4 have been consolidating their understanding of place value in 4-digit numbers. We have been working on being able to compare and order numbers above 1000, as well as rounding these to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.

Science – We have been focusing on how to determine whether something is a 'living thing' and thinking about the range of different habitats. We will complete a range of exciting experiments and observations to enhance our understanding of living things and their habitats.

History - We have started our new topic which is the Ancient Greeks. We have already learnt about the Greeks starting a democracy and how this gave the citizens of Greece political influence. We have also focused on the first Olympic games, comparing how the games have changed from the first Ancient Greek games, in 776BC, to the present day.

Computing - Online safety has been our focus at the beginning of the term and we have created an agreement that all of the children have signed to show their dedication to taking a number of things into consideration when they use the internet.

Art - Linking this to our learning of the Ancient Greeks, the children will be learning about Greek architecture and the children have created their own 'wreath of victory' which we were introduced to when learning about the Greek goddess Nike..

Homework will relate to the work completed in class that week and will be given out on Fridays. Children are expected to complete the tasks and bring it back to school by the following Wednesday.
