





Odd Socks Day

First of all, thank you for your incredible support over the last 3 months. Despite all the restrictions in place, we have continued to be ambitious for the children and make the impossible possible. It was great that so many of you attended Parent Consultations remotely.

This terms focus across the school

This term we have worked incredibly hard to encourage the children to read for pleasure... some classes are now reading over 80 times a week at home every week.
