

Writing/phonics:

As well as our Success for all (SfA) learning, we will also be improving our writing through our topic work in the afternoons. We will be using our phonics sessions with our class teachers to develop our Phase 5 sounds and consolidate our reading and writing using alien words. We will also be widening our knowledge of spelling patterns.



Science:

At the beginning of the term we will be labelling parts of our bodies and discussing which parts are important, while also thinking about which parts of the body are associated with which senses.



Maths:



Year 1: We will be learning about addition and subtraction of numbers within 10. We will also be looking at one more and one less than a given number, as well as how to halve numbers. Towards the end of term we will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes.

Year 2: We will be exploring place value, addition and subtraction with number to 100. We will be exploring measuring length in metres and centimetres.

PSHE:

We will be talking about our school values of being ready, respectful and safe, and what these values mean. We will also be thinking about British values, as well as what it means to be a

We will be beginning to learn the basics of using a laptop, including using the keypad, how to log on, saving our work and dragging objects using the keypad. We will also focus on how to stay safe
