I would like to take this opportunity to say welcome to Ladybirds Class! I hope you all had a lovely summer and are looking forward to the year ahead of us.

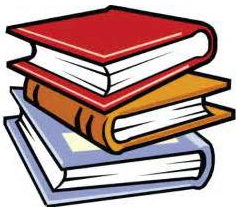

found.




Our Theme for this half term is 'Amazing me'. Please look at our topic web for details of the exciting things we will be learning about in each subject area.
